We had to get rid of the excess heat and bad air, but venting it was causing bad problems with static electricity (very bad for us because static can cause errors or computer lockups), and also it created cold drafts and the furnace ran almost 100% of the time to heat all the air that had to be made up (leaking back in from doors, windows etc.).
